Reports on Business Transacted; General Agents; Agents and non-resident Brokers

Section 1: General Agents or Managers

All General Agent or Managers that represent foreign insurers in Puerto Rico will file a report with the Commissioner on insurance business transacted during the six-month periods ending on June 30 and December 31 of each calendar year. The report will be submitted on the forms supplied by the Commissioner and will be filed with the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance within the month following the respective six-month period. If no business was transacted, it will be so indicated on the form.

Section 2: Agents and Non-resident Brokers

All resident agents and non-resident brokers will file an annual report with the Commissioner using forms provided by the Commissioner and covering business transacted during the preceding calendar year ending on December 31. The report will be filed on or before March 30 of each year. If no business was transacted, it will be so indicated on the form.
